Title: TENDERS

North Trunk Sanitary Sewer Contract #2 - Lift Station

#### **BACKGROUND / PROPOSAL:**

The lift station is proposed to be located at the existing La Crete sewage lagoon to lift flows from the proposed trunk main into the lagoon. The lift station also includes a short section of force main from the lift station to the lagoon inflow manhole, other minor improvements to the lagoon intake, and will be able to accommodate additional future tie-ins.

The design of the lift station was completed by Associated Engineering. Helix Engineering completed the work on the North trunk Sanitary Sewer. Both companies collaborated together to bring this project to tender.

The Phase 1 basin services approximately 1420 acres of a mix of residential and commercial/industrial land including 554 acres of low-pressure sewer. It is also sized to accommodate additional flow volume from further west/southwest.

Helix Engineering Ltd posted the tender on Alberta Purchasing Connection (APC) on May 3, 2024, with a revised closing date of May 28, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. local time.

The scope of work for the project includes but is not limited to:

- Construction of a sanitary pumping station including wet well, pumps and mechanical, electrical, building and backup generator
- Construction of the lagoon chamber
- Connection of force mains to lagoon chamber
- Diversion of an existing force main to the lagoon chamber
- Gravity connection from Lagoon chamber to existing lagoon cells
- Siteworks including roads, yard gravelling and grading and fencing

Administration, before bringing a recommendation was awaiting the results of North Trunk Sanitary Sewer Contact #2 (lift station) bids and scoring matrix. As the lift station is part of the Hamlet of La Crete North Trunk Sanitary Sewer project, and may affect the overall project budget.

Administration has thoroughly reviewed the low bids, as has the engineer. A legal review was also obtained in order to ensure that no details were missed by either administration or the engineer. There are no technical or legal items that effect the viability of the low bid

#### **OPTIONS & BENEFITS:**

#### Scenario #1

Administration would recommend awarding the Hamlet of La Crete North Trunk Sanitary Sewer to the lowest bidder while staying within budget, if the qualified lift station bids are within budget.

#### Scenario #2

If the lift station qualified bids come in modestly higher, the recommendation may be to award to the lowest bidder, with a budget amendment.

Title: Budget Amendment - Additional Re-gravelling

#### **BACKGROUND / PROPOSAL:**

Due to the recent rain, administration has received numerous calls from ratepayers requesting gravel and road maintenance. This is an issue in all areas of our County as several roads were not accessible by emergency vehicles. Many of these very wet, muddy problem roads were not on the list for the 2024 Re-gravelling Program therefore, they are not included in the contract. These new requests have been calculated at 80 miles.

Administration would like Council to consider a budget amendment of \$850,000 to be added for the re-gravelling of these identified roads. A combination of local gravel purchase and using gravel from County Pits will be used to re-gravel these roads.

#### **OPTIONS & BENEFITS:**

#### Option 1:

Approving a budget amendment for an additional \$850,000 to be used for addressing deteriorating roads.

#### Benefit:

Ensuring municipal road infrastructure is maintained, and ensuring accessibility for ratepayers and emergency services.
