The major issues that were brought up by the public was that the M.D. needs to be more receptive to rural subdivisions – allowing up to three

subdivisions per quarter section. The size of subdivisions should be left up to the developer, allowing any size from two acres to 80-acre subdivisions. Weed control becomes a problem when subdivisions are larger than what is needed. There was also a suggestion that land adjacent to the Peace River and Wadlin Lake be opened for acreages. Concern was expressed that if the MD will not accommodate desirable subdivisions people will move away, which will decrease the tax base.

Reeve Neufeld thanked the public for their input and recessed the meeting at 8:09 p.m.
