Legislation Reference Municipal Government Act, Section 18

Purpose

To control the regrowth of brush along municipal roads.

Policy Statement and Guidelines

The Council for the M.D. of Mackenzie No. 23 shall develop plans for brush control for inclusion in the long range and annual road programs.

Public Awareness/Consultation that adjacent landowners wanting shelterbelts should develop these on their own property, not the road allowance, should be increased.

The tentative schedule for completing work shall be:

Year 1 – brushing and disposal of brush piles

Year 2 – roadside spraying for weeds and trees

Year 3 – ditch cleaning and definition

When spraying is the method chosen:

- Only herbicides registered for roadside brush control will be used
- Application will be by a certified applicator in accordance with Alberta regulations

Environmental impacts shall be considered during brush control operations in accordance with the Industrial Vegetation Management Association of Alberta Standards and Good Practices.
