

BYLAW NO. 206/00

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE NO. 23,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSEING AND SELLING
A PORTION OF PUBLIC ROAD
IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 AND 606
OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER 31,
STATUTES OF ALBERTA, 1994, AS AMENDED.**

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council to have those lands closed, and

WHEREAS, a notice of intention of the Council to pass a bylaw has been published in a locally circulated newspaper in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any persons prejudicially affected by the bylaw, and a public hearing was held in accordance with the Municipal Government Act where all parties claiming to be affected were present and were heard by Council,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23 in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, does hereby close and sell a portion of public road described as follows and as shown on Schedule "A", subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations:

All that portion of 102nd Street lying East of the production Northerly of the most Westerly boundary of Lot 7, Block 25, of said plan excepting thereout all mines and minerals, within the Hamlet of La Crete as described in attached Schedule "A".
