**A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE NO. 23
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

TO RESCIND DESIGNATED OFFICER BYLAWS 131/98 and 132/98

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1994, the Council must establish by bylaw, a position of Chief Administrative Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Administrative Officer may delegate any of the Chief Administrative Officer's powers, duties or functions under this or any other enactment or bylaw to an employee of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Purpose

1. The purpose of this bylaw is to rescind the following bylaws creating designated officer positions:
 - (a) Bylaw 131/98, Treasurer
 - (b) Bylaw 132/98, Municipal Secretary
 - (c) Bylaw 202/00, Agricultural Fieldman

2. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon the third and final reading thereof.
