Title: Seeking Input for Capital Plan Priorities (ADDITION)

BACKGROUND / PROPOSAL:

Mackenzie County has been contacted by MLA Jabbour as they are currently determining infrastructure priorities for the Minister of Infrastructure and Transportation.

The Capital Plan priorities must be in-line with the government's three guiding pillars, for suture consideration. The three pillars are as follows:

- Supports the key social programs and services that government provide to Albertans.
- Supports economic development in the province.
- Supports environmental outcomes.

The following are suggestions for submission:

Capital priorities include new and expansion projects that will: support the ongoing delivery and/or enhancement of programs and services provided by government, maintenance funding to restore an existing asset to its functional condition or to extend its useful life; and funding for capital grants.

Council must provide sufficient detail to allow Minister of Infrastructure and Transportation of the projects' merits and state of readiness for funding consideration. This will allow MLA Debbie Jabbour to better advocate for those projects.

OPTIONS & BENEFITS:

This would provide Mackenzie County an opportunity to take a thoughtful and prudent approach for the planning and implementation of priority capital projects and programs.
