

**BY-LAW No. 073/96**

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE  
MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE No. 23,  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,  
TO ADOPT THE 1996 ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR 1997**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of Section 286 and 287 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapters M-26.1, R.S.A., and transitional regulation 372/94 section 2 (2), it is necessary that a Bylaw be passed on or before December 31, to authorize the assessor to adopt assessments prepared in the previous year,

**NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE No. 23, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the assessment roll for 1996 be adopted as the assessed values of property for the year 1997, with the exception that, all properties in the opinion of the assessor that require a re-assessment including but not limited to
  - a) Machinery and Equipment
  - b) all other assessable property the value of which is decreased by the destruction of an improvement on it or by some cause other than fair wear and tear, and
  - c) all other assessable property the value of which is increased by the erection, completion or repair of an improvement on it or by some other cause,
2. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon signing.
