BYLAW NO. 394/03

BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE NO. 23 IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 348/03 TO CLOSE A PORTION OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 22 AND 606 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000.

WHEREAS, Council of the Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23 passed all three readings of Bylaw 348/03 thereby closing the road allowance between the north and south quarters of sections 18, 17, 16, and W 15-105-15-W5M and section 13-105-16-W5M, in accordance with the Municipal Government Act Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and

WHEREAS, Bylaw 348/03 was submitted to Alberta Registries for registration, and

WHEREAS, Alberta Registries rejected the descriptions used to identify the portion of road to be closed,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23 does hereby amend the road description in Bylaw 348/03 to read as follows:

1. Meridian 5, Range 16, Township 105

All that portion of the government road adjoining the south boundary of the south east and south west quarters of section 13-105-16-5 which lies east of a line drawn from the point of intersection of the east limit of Road Plan 1190PX with the said south boundary to the point of intersection of the east limit of Road Plan 1190PX with the north boundary of the NW ¼ 12-105-16-5.

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

- Meridian 5, Range 15, Township 105 The Government Road adjoining the south boundary of the S ½ 18-105-15-5. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
- Meridian 5, Range 15, Township 105 The Government Road adjoining the south boundary of the S ½ 17-105-15-5. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
- Meridian 5, Range 15, Township 105 The Government Road adjoining the south boundary of the S ½ 16-105-15-5. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

- Meridian 5, Range 15, Township 105 All that portion of the Government Road adjoining the south boundary of the SW ¼ 15-105-15-5 and lying west of the production southerly of the west limit of Road Plan 1862LZ. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
- 6. That this Bylaw shall come into effect upon the passing of the third and final reading of this Bylaw.
