**BEING A BYLAW OF THE
MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE NO. 23
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO AUTHORIZE
THE PROVISION OF PROVINCIAL E911 SERVICE
IN THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE NO. 23**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property.

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23, in the Province of Alberta, wishes to provide Provincial E911 service within the Municipality and enter into agreements with other agencies and/or municipalities to provide such service.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE NO. 23, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23 will enter into an agreement with TELUS Communications Inc. to provide access to emergency services via its Provincial E911 Service.
2. The Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23 will enter into an agreement with TELUS Communications Inc. in order that TELUS Communications Inc. will act as a billing and collecting agent for the Call Answer Service.
3. A customer within the Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23 who subscribes to TELUS Communications Inc. Exchange Service will be provided with the E911 service and be required to pay fees for said service.
4. The adoption of this bylaw is effective upon the date of the passing of the third and final reading of this resolution.
