

BYLAW NO. 115/97

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE
MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE No. 23,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,**

**TO AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSOR TO ADOPT
THE 1997 ASSESSMENT ROLL**

WHEREAS, under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 286 and 287 of the Municipal Government Act it is necessary that a Bylaw be passed on or before December 31 to authorize the Assessor to adopt assessments prepared in the previous year.

NOW THEREFORE, COUNCIL OF THE Municipal District of Mackenzie No. 23, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Municipal Committees

1. That subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, the Assessor is authorized to use the assessed value of property as shown on the assessment roll for 1997 as the assessed value of property for the year 1998, with the exception of the following:

All properties that, in the opinion of the assessor requires a re-assessment including but not limited to:

Machinery and Equipment

All other assessable property the value of which is decreased by the destruction of an improvement on it or by some cause other than fair wear and tear, and

All other assessable property the value of which is increased by the erection, completion or repair of an improvement on it by some other cause.

2. This bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading thereof.
