BACKGROUND / PROPOSAL:

July 28th, 2014, Administration received an email (attached) from Abe Fehr with the La Crete Recreation Board regarding the old Buffalo Head Prairie skate shack, which is being replaced with the new construction this year.

The La Crete Recreation Board is asking what the County's process would be for the removal of the old skate shack. Would the County look after, or can the La Crete Recreation Society decide what to do with it.

In an email received from Mr.Fehr (attached) it states that a private individual is interested in removing the building from site, and absorbing the moving cost but with no compensation to be paid to the County/Board for the building.

Administration took pictures (attached) of the building in question, to ascertain if the building would be of any use to other Societies, or facilities within Mackenzie County. As the removal date from the location is a short notice for Societies to prepare the ground, and allocate funds, only the La Crete Polar Cats could commit (email attached).

Requested removal date is August 25th, 2014.
