3.1 Bylaw 551/06 – Land Use Bylaw Amendment Rezoning Part of SW 3-110-18-W5M

Reeve Neufeld called the public hearing for Bylaw 551/06 to order at 6:00 p.m.

Reeve Neufeld asked if the public hearing for proposed Bylaw 551/06 was properly advertised. Eva Schmidt, Planning Supervisor, answered that the bylaw was advertised in accordance with the Municipal Government Act.

Reeve Neufeld asked the Development Authority to outline the proposed Land Use Bylaw Amendment. Planning Supervisor Schmidt presented the Development Authority's submission and indicated that first reading was given on January 25, 2006.

The applicant believes that the subject property would be suitable for commercial/industrial zoning as it is adjacent to Hwy 58, six miles east of the Town of High Level, and further that there is a lack of large available and economically priced lots that suit the larger industrial operations.

This property is not within the Intermunicipal Development Plan area.

Reeve Neufeld asked if Council had any questions of the proposed Land Use Bylaw Amendment. There were no questions.

Reeve Neufeld asked if any submissions were received in regards to proposed Bylaw 551/06. Planning Supervisor Schmidt answered that there were two letters from adjacent landowners, both of whom were opposed to rezoning. One letter indicated that a lack of information regarding the future of the property was an issue.

Reeve Neufeld asked if there was anyone present who would like to speak in regards of the proposed Bylaw 551/06. There was no indication that anyone present wished to speak.

Sam Moustafa, an adjacent property owner and owner of Samland Homes, spoke of having filled in his property to make it suitable for his security suite. He is planning to put a used mobile home business next to his suite and is concerned about this rezoning.

The subject land is approximately three miles south of the Town of High Level, mostly treed and not largely cleared for agriculture. The applicant intends to develop the quarter in phases, eventually turning the complete quarter into a multi-lot country residential subdivision. This parcel is outside of the Intermunicipal Development Plan, but close enough that notification was sent to the Town of High Level and Alberta Transportation.

Reeve Neufeld asked if Council had any questions of the proposed Land Use Bylaw Amendment. There were several questions, which the Planning Supervisor answered.

Reeve Neufeld asked if any submissions were received in regards to proposed Bylaw 535/05. Planning Supervisor Schmidt indicated that an adjacent acreage owner objected to the proposed rezoning. Dust, noise and sewer pump-outs were of concern, as was the increase in truck traffic and the reduction of farmland.

Reeve Neufeld asked if there was anyone present who would like to speak in regards to the proposed Bylaw 535/05. There was no indication that anyone present wished to speak.
